



## City of Houston Access Badge Program

Congratulations and thank you for joining our dedicated group of volunteers at BARC Animal Shelter & Adoptions! We appreciate your service and commitment to improving the lives of animals in the City of Houston.

As a volunteer for the City, you will need an access badge to present to the security guard at the back gate of BARC, 2700 Evella Street. You can easily acquire your own personalized access badge at the City Administration Building on 611 Walker Street. Here is a picture of the Administration Building front door where you will enter. Present your photo ID to the security guard and tell them that you are there for a Volunteer Access Badge. They will direct you to the Badging Office on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, where you will present your ID and signed Access Badge Form in exchange for your new Volunteer Access Badge. The Badging Office is open Tuesdays & Thursdays, 8am-3pm.



*Minors without a driver's license are not eligible for a city access badge. They can access BARC when accompanied by their supervising parent or guardian if their parent presents an access badge.*
