Qualified recipients (proof of military disability) for the free spay/neuter surgeries **MUST** have this flyer to redeem for a free spay or neuter surgery for their dog. Surgeries are on a first come, first served basis beginning as early as **6:30 am on May 27th**.

Important preparation note: No food for your dog after 10pm. Exemptions to this rule are dogs 4-6 months old. All animals must be brought on a leash or in a carrier.  
*All dogs should be a minimum of 4 months old or maximum of 8 years old.*
