

GENERAL GOVERNMENT FACILITIES

The FY2010-2014 General Government Facilities Improvements Program includes funding for several categories of projects that rely primarily on General Improvement Bond funds. These projects are either citywide in nature or are not funded through one of the major departmental programs. The CIP provides \$23.6 million in General Improvement Public Improvement Bond appropriations, distributed in three sections of the CIP; General Government, Public Library, and Parks and Recreation. Additionally, General Improvement funds are used to support the Miller Outdoor Theatre, a facility operated by the Convention and Entertainment Department.

Highlights of the Adopted FY2010 – 2014 CIP include:

- Replacement of the system at the Miller Outdoor Theater
- Parking Improvements along the Pierce Elevated Lots
- Accessibility improvements at the Miller Outdoor Theatre
- Expand and renovate the Magnolia Multi-Service Center.
- Upgrade of the Computer Network Infrastructure citywide
- Respond to emergency environmental remediation needs
- A Job Order Contract for miscellaneous construction work
