Fire Protection Facilities

The Houston Fire Department is committed to providing a superior level of emergency service that continually improves the quality of life, health and safety of the people we serve--the citizens of Houston. Houston Fire does this by serving the community with Courage, Commitment and Compassion.

The goal of the Houston Fire Department is to continuously improve Public Safety, Infrastructure, and Quality of Life through the Capital Improvement Plan.

The Fire program for the FY2014–2018 Capital Improvement Plan incorporates a three-point plan of new construction, renovation/rehabilitation, and relocation to expand and maintain its network of fire stations and facilities in support of its infrastructure.

Highlights of the Adopted FY2014 – 2018 CIP include:

- The new 5 bay Fire Station #84 located @ 300 Gears Rd. would serve the Greenspoint's community, by immediately relieving over – extended resources within the impacted and surrounding area. The new station will provide increased living area and equipment storage for a more safe and healthy living environment for the members. The construction of the new facility would immediately improve the infrastructure deficiencies and greatly benefit firefighter safety, life safety and property conservation for a growing community.
- The extensive renovation of Fire Stations #66 & #68 will extend the useful life of the facility by replacing and upgrading its core features such as; HVAC, Mechanical, and Plumbing. Meanwhile extending the parking area and increasing living space will enhance the quality of life for the members.
