At the Center.....

The public will be able to have their plans reviewed for opportunities to add green strategies to save energy, save water and make their buildings healthier.

The Resource Center has been designed as a combination waiting room, showroom, classroom and library of information with the physical space serving as a green building demonstration project itself, registered to achieve LEED for Commercial Interiors.

Customers will be able to peruse the shelves and displays, touch and feel samples, and learn about green building options in a relaxed setting where they can browse on their own, use an interactive kiosk, or ask questions of the staff Program Director, Steve Stelzer.

A 250 gallon raintank collects water from the roof drain line. A moisture sensor in a planter controls our irrigation. If it is dry, and the sun is out, a timer will start the solar powered pump to water the plants in our reclaimed planters.
