A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON RUNOFF ELECTION HELD ON DECEMBER 2, 1975, AND COUNTING THE VOTES CAST; MAKING VARIOUS FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT; AND DECLARING THE OFFICIAL RESULTS OF SAID ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines:

(1) This Resolution is adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council, being the first regular meeting after the day of the election hereinafter mentioned.

(2) In accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Houston there was held in the City of Houston on December 2, 1975, the City of Houston runoff election for the election of the officers of the City as to those positions where no candidate received a majority of all votes cast at the general election held on November 4, 1975.

(3) Said election was regularly ordered and notice thereof regularly given for the time and in the manner provided by law. It was regularly held in accordance with the orders therefor and the notices thereof.

(4) The returns of the election, properly certified, were made and returned in the manner required by law.

Section 2. The returns of said election, having been here and now examined by the City Council in open meeting, the City Council finds and determines therefrom that a total of 242,647 persons voted at said election and that at said election the following candidates received the number of votes indicated opposite their respective names below:

Section 3. On the basis of the canvass above mentioned, the City Council finds and declares:

(1) Fred Hofheinz received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Mayor, and was elected to that office.

(2) Louis Macey received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Councilman, District C. and was elected to that office.
