What is the goal of Complete Communities?

The Complete Communities initiative will revitalize Houston's under-resourced communities. The City will work with local stakeholders and partners across Houston to create more complete communities with enhanced access to quality affordable homes, jobs, well-maintained parks, improved streets and sidewalks, grocery stores and retail, good schools, and quality transportation options.

What are the pilot Complete Communities?

The City has selected the following five pilot communities for the Complete Communities initiative:

Third Ward

Gulfton

Second Ward

What is the project timeline?

The program, which started April 2017, will conduct a 6 to 9 month community engagement process to help local residents and businesses identify improvements to strengthen communities, as follows:
