POLICY –

GENERAL – The City of Houston has three main categories of city policies administratively controlled within the executive branch of government, implementing the City Charter and Code of Ordinances. They are defined as the following categories:

Use and reference to these categories of policies and documentation are implicitly made herein and are considered a part of the organizational and operational performance of the AD. For example, AD Attribute Policy 115.00, Proficiency, Competency and Professional Development makes reference to the Houston Employee Assessment and Review (HEAR) Process. HEAR is promulgated within the City of Houston by AP 3-20. This practice is consistent throughout all of the AD policies and procedures without regard to category of policy (AP, EO or MP).

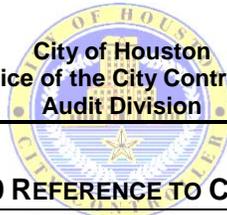
