**Council Member Jerry Davis takes aim at delinquent structures in Acres  
Homes on Demolition Day**

**HOUSTON — May 17, 2012** — On May 19th, 2012, District B Council Member Jerry Davis will meet with residents in Acres Homes in this year's Demolition Day. District B has the highest number of properties to be torn down in the city with 112 buildings scheduled for demolition. The buildings being demolished are seriously neglected and dilapidated properties that have become eye sores and epicenters for crime throughout the district.

“Revitalizing our neighborhoods is one of our main goals in District B. Demolishing these delinquent structures is just the first step toward repairing our communities,” Davis said of the demolitions. “Not only will Demo Day help in restoring this area, Acres Homes has been selected as a targeted neighborhood to receive Round 2 Ike funding as announced earlier this week.” The Round 2 Ike funds will focus on repairing whole neighborhood blocks as opposed to single residences scattered over the city. “With both these efforts combined, we are making a positive impact in our neighborhoods moving District B forward.”

Demolition Day would not be possible without the Houston Contractor's Association and the individual contractor's that are volunteering their time and equipment in all of the demolition day efforts.
