Council Member Davis to be Joined by Mayor Annise Parker to Break Ground on Hirsch Road Grade Separation

HOUSTON — February 20, 2012 — Houston City Council Member Jerry Davis and Mayor Annise Parker are scheduled to break ground on the Hirsch Road Paving and Drainage project in Trinity Gardens. The project will expand a two-lane major thoroughfare to four-lane. The drainage system that is in need of major upgrades will be completely replaced and a bridge will be built to allow traffic to be separated from the train tracks. The community has lobbied for these upgrades and traffic separation from the train tracks and Council Member Davis is pleased to unveil the plans to the community. “I see this project as something that needs to be celebrated because the voice of the community was heard,” said Council Member Davis.
