


## HPD MUNICIPAL COURT OVERTIME Problem Statement

#### Resource Management Issues:

- 100 to 170 officers appear in Municipal Court, Monday-Friday
- Overtime Compensation: The average officer overtime compensation rate is \$45.23 per hour
- Trials by Judge (Bench): Average officer completes appearance within 2 hours.

(average cost = \$90.46)

Jury Trials: Jury Trials do not usually begin until 1:00 p.m., over 5 hours after the officer's report time. (average cost= over \$226.15)



For the past four fiscal years, Trials by Jury settings are nearly as prevalent as Trials by Judge settings.

### HPD MUNICIPAL COURT OVERTIME Analysis of FY08 Municipal Court Compensation

#### Overtime Investment:


- HPD paid over \$4.5 million in Municipal Court Overtime
- \$3.5 million Officer Overtime for Jury Trials was estimated at over
- Overtime associated with Jury Trials accounted for 77.1% of Municipal Court paid compensation

#### Return on Investment:

- Cases set for Bench Trial = 355,754 (50.4%)
- Cases set for Jury Trial = 349,625 (49.6%)
- Actual Bench Trials = Unavailable
- Actual Jury Trials = 746
- occur Less than 1% (0.2%) of all cases set for Jury Trial
