Texas Enterprise Zone Nominations for June 3 Application Deadline

Texas Enterprise Zone TX Tax Code Chapter 2303

- Program is administered by the State of Texas and has a quarterly rolling application process.
- Reimbursement of state sales/use tax for qualifying projects.
- Both Municipalities and Counties are allotted nine (9) nominations each state biennium. Unused
 nominations are forfeited at the end of the biennium.
 - June 3 is the fourth nomination round in this biennium cycle. Four nomination rounds remain.
 - Nominated 1 project so far
 - Proposing to use 2 of our 8 remaining nominations
- Nominations do not require any funding from the municipality.
- A County can only nominate a project through an interlocal agreement with the Municipality in which the project is located.




