




#### Avalon Place Neighborhood Reconstruction Project Identified Needs

- Pedestrian/bike safety and accessibility






## Avalon Place Neighborhood Reconstruction Project Planned Updates




#### Avalon Place Neighborhood Reconstruction Project Proposed Sidewalk Plan

The following sidewalk improvements are being planned as part of this project.





#### Avalon Place Neighborhood Reconstruction Project Driveway Construction Options

**Option 1**: Replace the broken length and width of the driveway with plain reinforced cement concrete at no cost to the home owner.



**Option 2**: Grade the subgrade to proper slope and form the driveway to meet the new grades /slope. You would see the finished dirt with the proper slope. Homeowner will finish the driveway with their desired finish at their cost. (Driveway must be finished 2 weeks after it's been prepped by the City.)
