



Updating Solid Waste Yard Signs

To maximize savings, trash pick-up dates will change -- effective November 1, 2012. Neighborhoods (via civic associations) that have yard signs indicating their *current* service day should call 311 and ask for new labels for their new service day. The Solid Waste Dept. will mail the new labels to the civic association contact person. Please do not throw away your existing signs!!

Currently, neighborhoods can receive up to FIVE (5) signs for tree waste and FIVE (5) signs for junk waste. The new service days are already on the Solid Waste Dept. website. As you click the webpage, www.houstonsolidwaste.org, there is a box on the left-hand side that says, "We're Stopping by on a New Day!" Follow the links in that box, put in your address, and the new service day will appear.

Also, to see the improved service maps with your new neighborhood schedule collection date, simply log onto the Solid Waste Management Department's website at www.houstonsolidwaste.org. The website will also enable you to read about other Solid Waste Dept. services for your area.
