Please bring 1 of the following forms of Identification to register:

- Driver's License,
- Personal Identification card,
- Concealed Handgun License,
- Military Identification with photo,
 - U.S. Passport,
- U.S. Citizenship Certificate.

All must be current or expired no longer than 60 days from voting.

You are eligible to register to vote if:

- You are a United States citizen;
- You are a resident of the county where you submit the application;
 - You are at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- You are not a convicted felon (you may be eligible to vote if you have completed your sentence, probation, and parole); and
- You have not been declared by a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be either totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote
