Project Description: Clean, purge and prepare two tanks for in-place closure. Installation of one 5,000 gallon aboveground storage tank along with associated appurtenance. Remove two 4,000 gallon UST's (gasoline and diesel) including piping. Work also includes disposal of aqueous liquid, saw-cutting, demolition and removal of concrete, backfilling, waste classification, hauling and proper disposal.
