



Getting vaccinated is FREE and does not require proof of residency, citizenship, or insurance.

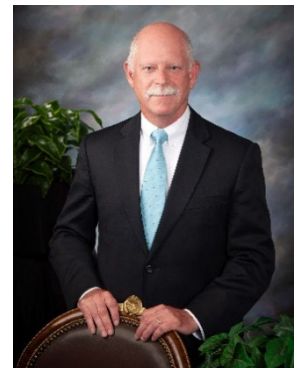
