**DOCUMENTARY DESCRIPTION**

African-Americans make up 13% of the U.S. population but account for over 50% of all new cases of HIV, the virus that causes AIDS. That infection rate is eight times the rate of whites. Among women the numbers are even more shocking-68% of all newly diagnosed HIV positive women in the U.S. are African-American women. African-American women are 23 times more likely to be diagnosed with AIDS than white women, with heterosexual contact being the overwhelming mode of infection in **Black America**.
