

FOOD SERVICE MANAGER'S CERTIFICATION CLASSES 2017

The City of Houston Food Ordinance requires the presence of a food service manager (s) in food establishments during all stages of operation. Students must complete the course and pass the examination with a score of 70 points or above in order to receive a certificate, valid for 5 years. **Effective February 2, 2016 the city provides a 1 day (9 hour) course and an optional exam to obtain the certificate. Renewal classes are no longer offered. (Obtain a new certification: complete the "class" or Optional Exam, or by reciprocity).**

THE CITY OF HOUSTON FOOD SERVICE MANAGER'S CERTIFICATE IS VALID ONLY IN THE CITY OF HOUSTON

Reservations and pre-payment are required for all classes. Class size is limited.

FOOD CERTIFICATION CLASS RESERVATIONS: MONDAY- FRIDAY, 7:30AM-4PM @ 832.393.5100

Students will receive a letter with instructions including the payment due dates, a map of class location, and invoice. Return the invoice and payment together. Call the office if you have not received your packet at least 10 days before class.

◇ FEES

A non-refundable fee must be paid prior to the date of the class.

Payment may be received by mail or in person at the Department of Health and Human Services Department, 8000 N. Stadium Drive.

◇ CLASS CHECK IN

Begins at 7:00 a.m. unless otherwise indicated according to the location. Photographic identification is required for admission into the class: current driver's license, state identification card, student ID card, passport, etc. Students arriving late for class will not be admitted. Bring pencil, pen, paper for taking notes.

OPTIONAL EXAM SESSIONS:

February, June, October.

OPTIONAL EXAM : There are no lectures. This option is for persons who have knowledge of current food safety practices or have prepared by studying the course manual. Call for reservations.

Some food establishments are exempt from the FSMC requirement: This is based on the type of operation and, must be confirmed by an inspection from the City of Houston Food Inspection sanitarian.

RECIPROCITY: Food personnel in possession of a current accredited national or State of Texas food safety card/certificate must obtain the City of Houston Food Service Manager's Certification. Complete an application at the DHHS office; submit the certificate for confirmation of reciprocity and photo identification. If approved, pay the **\$39.13** fee.

ON-LINE COURSES: The City of Houston does not provide on-line courses at this time.
