HOUSTON/HARRIS COUNTY STATISTICS HIV/AIDS IN 2007


 Hispanics comprise 41% of the Houston/Harris County population, 25% of the 1,188 HIV diagnoses and 28% of the 867 AIDS diagnoses in 2007.

 In 2007, Hispanics accounted for 32% of AIDS diagnoses in men and 17% of those in women. Hispanics also accounted for 29% of HIV diagnoses in men and 16% of those in women.

 Cumulatively through 2007, 3,265 (21%) of Houston/Harris County's 15,552 HIV cases were Hispanic.

 In 2006, HIV was the 5th leading cause of death among Hispanic men and the 3rd leading cause of death among women, ages 25-44.
