Central Presbyterian Church on Richmond Avenue is one of the finest examples of Mid Century Modern church architecture in Houston. The Richmond Avenue building was designed 1960-1962 by Wilson, Morris, Crain & Anderson the church has ministered in Houston for 110 years. Faced with declining membership and a facility too large, the congregation has moved from the property and the site presently is being marketed for redevelopment. The outstanding interiors include two large glass murals, custom-designed artwork and a variety of unique details.
