



## ANNOUNCING PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE CITY'S PLANS TO EXPEND MILLIONS IN FEDERAL FUNDS

The City of Houston Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) has prepared the **DRAFT 2014 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**, which serves as the annual application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for federal entitlement grants, including CDBG, HOME, HOPWA and ESG. HCDD's allocation of federal funds will provide the following services for Houstonians: affordable housing, single-family home repairs, economic development, neighborhood facilities and improvements, and programs serving the youth, homeless, persons living with AIDS, and people with special needs.
