

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Houston, Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) is seeking "Proposals" from qualified general contractor(s), companies, organization and or agencies that are capable and desirous of serving as General Contractor(s) to undertake housing rehabilitation under the HCDD's Minor Critical Emergency Home Repair Program (MCEHRP). The purpose of this program is to alleviate life, health, or safety hazards at Eligible Residences located within the City of Houston jurisdictional boundaries including areas within Fort Bend County that are serviced by the City of Houston and subject to pay City of Houston property taxes.
