Dear Ms. Warren:

On March 26, 2009, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) executed the City of Houston, Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) grant agreement.

In reference to NSP requirements pertaining to *Quarterly* and *Monthly* reporting in the Federal Register at pg. 58341, (O)(b)(i), the following reporting requirements are presented for the October 15<sup>th</sup> monthly reporting period:

- HCDD has not expended or awarded NSP funds for any proposed NSP program services, vendor services or for any service, nor have any funds been drawn for administration; therefore, HCDD has not posted any obligations or expenditures.
- HCDD announced the intent to substantially amend the NSP plan and 2008 Consolidated Action Plan on September 24, 2009. A summary of the Amendment was published in the Houston Chronicle newspaper and residents were encouraged to submit comments during the fifteen day review period. In addition, the NSP summary was placed on HCDD's website. HCDD did not receive any comments/questions about NSP.
