Dear Ms. Warren:

On March 26, 2009, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) executed the City of Houston, Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD) Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) grant agreement.

In reference to NSP requirements pertaining to *Quarterly* and *Monthly* reporting in the Federal Register at pg. 58341, (O)(b)(i), the following reporting requirements are presented for the November 15th monthly reporting period:

- HCDD has not expended or awarded NSP funds for any proposed NSP program services, vendor services or for any service, nor have any funds been drawn for administration; therefore, HCDD has not posted any obligations or expenditures.
- On Wednesday, December 09, 2009, City Council approved an ordinance amending City of Houston Ordinance No. 2008-1051 passed on November 19, 2008, which approved and authorized substantial amendment to the 2008 Consolidated Action Plan by adding a new grant for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP), to redistribute funding for projects under NSP. Information regarding these changes will be sent to HUD once the ordinance is signed and finalized.
