As a requirement for the Disaster Recovery Round 2, Phase 2 Application, the City of Houston will hold a Public Hearing to discuss the Fair Housing Action Statement - Texas (FHAAT) approved by the State's General Land Office, which will become the basis for the City of Houston's Fair Housing Action Plan.

The public is invited to provide comments on any proposed changes to the City's FHAAT. Public comments provided at the Hearing will be reviewed to either amend or accept the City's FHAAT. Upon approval, the FHAAT will become the basis of the City of Houston's Fair Housing Plan.
