


INWOOD FOREST GOLF COURSE DETENTION

HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROJECT

WHITE OAK BAYOU WATERSHED

The Inwood Forest Golf Course was acquired in 2011 by the City of Houston and will be repurposed for 12 stormwater detention basins to provide flood reduction benefits to homes in the community. The project will also serve to mitigate the impacts for future drainage projects planned in the adjacent neighborhoods by Houston Public Works.
