PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS WITH YOU WHEN YOU MEET WITH A LAWYER:

- Current DACA work permit (EAD)
- Social security card and State-issued ID
- Birth certificate and Passport
- Current mailing address where you can safely receive mail for next 6 months
- Previous DACA approval notices from USCIS
- Copy of previous DACA application and Employment Authorization
- If you traveled, proof of advance parole and all travel-related documents (such as passport)
- If you have EVER been arrested, you must bring copy of arrest/court records
- 2 passport photos
- \$495 money order (If you do not have this, scholarships are available)

Bring all relevant documents, if available
