Spiders, Scorpions, and Snakes Slither Series Seminar Scheduled for Lake Houston Park

In the spirit of Halloween, Houston Parks and Recreation Department invites everyone to SSS... Spiders, Scorpions, and Snakes at Lake Houston Park. Led by Lake Houston Park Naturalist Jerry Walls, the class is part of an ongoing series of entertaining seminars designed to get folks acquainted with the natural world and the plants, animals, and bugs that live in it. People interested in learning the ins and outs of the lives of snakes, scorpions, and spiders can meet Jerry at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, October 28, 2006. The class is free with park admission.

The wildlife classes led by Jerry Walls take place in the natural beauty of Lake Houston Park and involve demonstrations with live creatures. Besides the ever-varying subject matter in Jerry's Saturday afternoon classes, he also leads park visitors on a bird watching tour of the park at 8:00 a.m. on the third Saturday of each month. The Peach Creek Peepers Bird Walk is also free with park admission. Lake Houston Park is located at 22031 Baptist Encampment Road, in New Caney. It is near the intersection of U.S. 59 and F.M. 1485.
