All volunteers must sign their registration and waiver form. There will be additional forms available at the event.



Locating Your Planting Site:

Each team will receive a site number such as NA10

- The first letter, N or S, indicates the North or South side of the esplanade.
- The second letter, A through G, indicates your assigned esplanade/
- Esplanade A is located near Lee Road. Esplanade G is located near McKay Road.
- The number indicates the site on the esplanade where your team will work.
- Sites are numbered sequentially on the esplanades from West to East
- Look for your site-number sign on your esplanade

Parking:

- Parking is limited! Please carpool if possible.
- Some parking will be available next to esplanades.
- Additional parking will be available at lot “D” on the Northeast corner of Lee Road and Will Clayton Parkway. Shuttle buses will provide transportation to and from lot.

- If you are not a member of a team, but would like to help plant trees, report to the West end of Esplanade A for training and assignment.

- Sunscreen and Bug spray.
- Children are welcome if accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Please, no pets.
