Second Annual Skatestock **Lee & Joe Jamail Skatepark** **Saturday, October 20, 2012**

WHAT:

The Second Annual Skatestock...peace, love and skateboards, will be held Saturday, October 20th, Lee and Joe Jamail Skatepark, noon - 9 p.m. Skatestock is a one-of-a-kind, FREE grass-roots, all day event connecting the dots between, skateboarding, music, art, and science. The park will be transformed into a massive open-air gallery featuring Houston's best artists and photographers. Master of Ceremonies will be Houston's own Chris Gentry of Pro Riders. The event will feature live music on two stages from Something Fierce, Hell City Kings, Sanctus Bellum, Tax the Wolf, Bald Eagle Burger, No Love Less, Pinky Lieder, Hershel Berry and the Natives, DJ Brother Roo, Ceeplus Bad Knives, DJ Cipher and many more. When the sun goes down surfing videos will be projected on the ceiling of the World's Largest Cradle while skaters enjoy carving through it. In addition, unique physics experiments will be conducted on the skater's velocity and weightlessness by Professor Adrian Lenardic, Rice University Earth Science Department. Everyone is encouraged to get their hands dirty and make some art. There will be several interactive workshops taking place throughout the park all day and night. Bring your cameras, your skateboards and curiosity and spend the entire day at the park.

Jamail Skater Alley Art

Anguilu along with several other notable artists **Sluke** from Austin, **Supher** from San Antonio and **Jaber** from Los Angeles will be collaborating on painting the panels that line the park entrance, skater alley. Anguilu strongly believes in freedom of expression and the need to use this

expression to decorate public spaces. His current team project is featured at **Lawndale Art Center** with a massive mural covering the north side of the building. The Jamail art panels have been a testimony of how community art adds to the public canvas. The mission of these panels and future workshops will be to promote mural art as a positive and dynamic creative force in our community.

Drive By Press will be rolling in from Brooklyn to educate and share the contemporary practice of printmaking with Houston. DBP began with an etching press in the back of a truck and a collection of 200 contemporary American prints but has evolved to three mobile operations, over 260 schools visited, and 250,000 miles traveled. DBP's main goal is to demonstrate the power of the multiple, educating students in various techniques, and shedding light on current trends in printmaking – the things that are happening right now across America. DBP loves the opportunity to share the prints, techniques, artists, and stories from the road with the masses.

Embassy Skateboards and preeminent skateboard photographer Lee Leal present a photo exhibition highlighting Texas skateboard legends as well as the finest skate boarders from around the world. Lee Leal's photos have been published in skateboarding magazines such as Thrasher, Juice, and Transworld Skateboarding. His photo of Tony Hawk resides in the pop culture exhibit of the Smithsonian Institute. Lee has traveled the world as a premier photographer for World Cup Skateboarding, the governing body of skateboard competitions. In 2009, Lee Leal and John "Tex" Gibson co-founded Embassy skateboards, a premier Texas skateboarding brand, with an esteemed team roster including Craig Johnson, Ken Fillion, Todd Prince, Mark Partain, Henry Gutierrez, Buck Smith, Ben Johnson, Max Peterson, Gary Morris, Pat Black, and Lash LaRue endorsing the wounded warrior project. Lee and the Embassy Ambassadors are on a mission to keep the "skate tuff or go home" attitude alive.

Houston Roller Derby will be making an appearance in a flash mob style performance. Don't miss out on seeing these fierce ladies attack the skate park!

The MOD Houston (Museum of Drawing Houston) will be setting up shop with a parlor game of Exquisite Corpse. Houston area artists will be on hand to guide attendees through this unique method of "composition in sequence" drawing. THE MOD is a space created to exhibit the origin of the line, the depth of drawing and the evolution of the line coming to life in modern and contemporary forms of video. The MOD strives to be an international influence pertaining to the significance and impact of drawing within today's dialogue. The MOD's exhibitions and programming are dedicated to providing resources and visual context of drawing and the diversity of drawing to our patrons and youth.
