The Houston Parks & Recreation Department will join more than 500 official **World's Largest Swimming Lesson™** (W.L.S.L.) host locations around the globe representing 24 countries on five continents and 46 states in the US to conduct **The World's Largest Swimming Lesson™**. The massive worldwide swim class is designed to spread the word that *Swimming Lessons Save Lives!* Organizers hope to break the previous Guinness World Record & spread the word that the best thing anyone (adults & children) can do to stay safe in and around the water is to learn to swim. As an official host location, HPARD will conduct **The World's Largest Swimming Lesson™** classes in 20 H.P.A.R.D. pools across the Houston area on June 14th at 10:00 a.m. Water parks, pools and other aquatic facilities around the globe & in Houston will also host local WLSL lessons simultaneously in an attempt to break the Guinness World Record.

Swimming is a life-saving skill for children and a vital tool to prevent drowning, the second leading cause of unintended, injury-related death for children ages 1-14. Research shows if a child doesn't learn to swim by the third grade, they likely never will. **The World's Largest Swimming Lesson™** was created to serve as a platform to help local community aquatic facilities and the many different national, regional and state wide water safety and drowning prevention organizations work together to tell this important story on a local and national level.
