PRESCRIBED FIRE AT SYLVAN RODRIGUEZ PARK POSTPONED DUE TO WEATHER

A prescribed fire scheduled for April 26-28 at Sylvan Rodriguez Park has been postponed due to the amount of rainfall the park received on Monday, April 25, 2022. The prescribed fire will be rescheduled for the fall. The event is a collaborative effort between the Houston Parks and Recreation Department (HPARD), Houston Fire Department (HFD), and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD).
