


TRAIL ALONG MEMORIAL DRIVE AT WEST RAVINE



EXISTING CONDITION

The Seymour Lieberman trail along Memorial Drive is currently located very close to fast moving traffic. This is an unpleasant experience for park users as they walk or run this stretch of trail. Moving the trail away from the road allows for a safer, shaded passage. The proposed trail realignment leads runners across two long bridges and over deep ravines. Weaving through the tree tops in established forest, the bridges create a memorable interlude along the route. This proposed improvement applies to both the 2.75 mile and 2.95 mile trail loop options.



TRAIL ALONG MEMORIAL DRIVE



Relocating the trail away from Memorial Drive separates the users from vehicular traffic and creates a shaded route through existing and proposed trees, transforming the user's experience to one of moving through the forest's edge. The trail will still be lighted and visible from the street for safety. The area along the street where the existing trail is located will be planted with trees as a buffer. Tree spacing will be designed to maintain views into the park from Memorial Drive. This proposed improvement applies to both the 2.75 mile and 2.95 mile trail loop options.
