CITY RECOGNIZES CLEAR LAKE SUPER NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL

HOUSTON, July 27, 2010 — Mayor Parker and the Houston City Council officially recognized the Clear Lake super neighborhood council at a ceremony in City Hall on July 27, 2010. This super neighborhood council successfully completed all the preliminary steps, which include gathering diverse stakeholder representation, creating an organizational structure and drafting by-laws.

At the recognition ceremony, the council was introduced to their City liaison. The liaison helps the council with their super neighborhood action plan, which identifies and prioritizes improvement projects. The liaison helps the council shepherd priority projects through the appropriate City processes. Clear Lake's liaison is Maria Bolanos in the Mayor's Citizens Assistance Office.

The Clear Lake Super Neighborhood lies in the southeastern most portion of the City of Houston. This thriving area is home to NASA's Manned Spacecraft Center and numerous aeronautics contractors. The area includes the master planned community of Clear Lake City, the adjacent communities of Pipers Meadow and Sterling Knoll, and numerous retail developments including Baybrook Mall. The close proximity to many amenities and attractions makes this area a desirable place to live, work and play.

We believe that super neighborhoods offer communities a way to communicate more effectively with the City and for residents and stakeholders a way to communicate more effectively with each other," said Marlene L. Gafrick, director of the Planning and Development Department. "It's an exciting dynamic for these neighborhoods and a great way for neighborhoods to implement projects."
