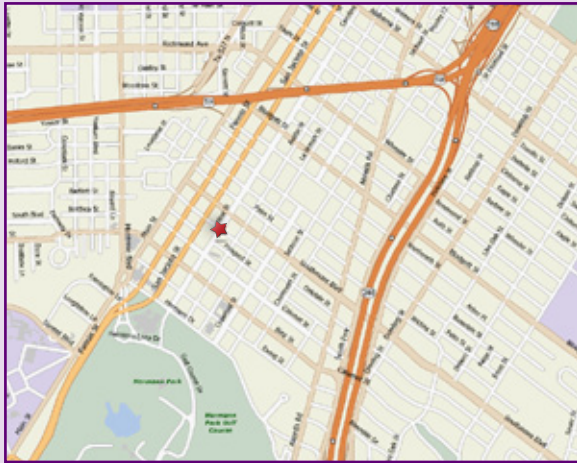


Neighborhood Leadership Institute Location Map

Learn to Lead with the Neighborhood Leadership Institute

The Planning & Development Department established the Neighborhood Leadership Institute (NLI) in 1996 to bring community leaders together, provide a forum for learning new skills, and enable individuals involved in improving their communities to share those skills with each other.
