- 1. Anyone wishing to speak before the Commission must sign up to speak on a designated form located at the entrance to Council Chambers.
- 2. If the speaker wishes to discuss a specific item on the agenda, it should be noted on the sign-up form.
- 3. If the speaker wishes to discuss any subject not otherwise on the agenda, time will be allocated or allotted after all agenda items have been processed and "public comments" are taken.
- 4. Applicants for a Certificate of Appropriateness and historic designations are provided the first opportunity to speak and are allowed five minutes for an opening presentation. The applicant is also permitted a three minute rebuttal after all speakers have been heard.
- 5. All other speakers will be permitted three minutes to address the Commission.
- 6. No speaker is permitted to accumulate speaking time from another person.
- 7. Time devoted to answering any questions from the Commission is not charged against allotted speaking time.
- 8. The commission reserves the right to limit speakers if it is the Commission's judgment that an issue has been sufficiently discussed and additional speakers are repetitive.
- 9. The Commission reserves the right to stop speakers who are unruly or abusive.
