Margaret Wallace Brown, Director for the Planning and Development Department, reported that the Brunner-Harmonium Historic District passed City Council yesterday (January 26, 2022.) She gave a 2021 report and current updates: A total of 156 COA's were approved 2021, which is more than COA's approved in 2020. The Commission recommended 18 properties to City Council in 2021 for landmark designation in 2021. There were 118 administrative approvals of Certificates of Appropriateness (COA's) last year, and 11 more as of this Monday.
