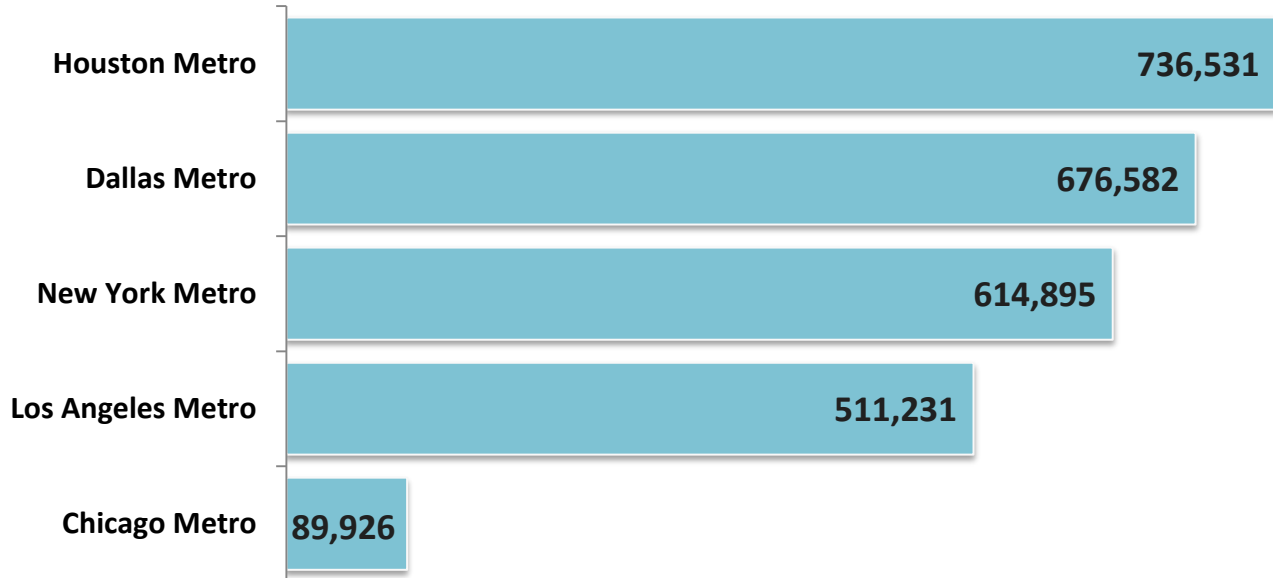

2010-2015 Population Gain Five Largest Metros in the US



- Of the five largest metros in the US, Houston Metro gained the most (736,531 persons) between 2010 and 2015 and Chicago gained the least (89,926 persons).
- In terms of percentage gain, Houston experienced 12.4%, followed by Dallas Metro 10.4%, Los Angeles Metro 4.5%, New York Metro 3.1% and Chicago 1% for the same period.
- Between 2014 and 2015, the Houston Metro gained 159,083 persons (or 2.4%). US Metro gain is 0.92%.
