Millennials Outnumber Baby Boomers

- Millennials, or America's youth born between 1982 and 2000, now number 83.1 million and represent more than one quarter of the nation's population. Their size exceeds that of the 75.4 million baby boomers.
- According to the Pew Research Center "They are also America's most racially diverse generation".
- Even more diverse than millennials are the youngest Americans: those younger than 5 years old. In 2014, this group became majority-minority for the first time, with 50.2 percent being part of a minority race or ethnic group.
- Five states were majority-minority (Total Population): Hawaii (77.0 %), the District of Columbia (64.2 %), California (61.5 %), New Mexico (61.1 %) and **Texas (56.5 %)**.
