


 **2013 Major Thoroughfare & Freeway Plan Amendment Request**

LATHROP STREET



LOCATION



REQUEST

Reclassify Lathrop Street between Wallisville and IH10 on hierarchy table from 4 lanes to 2 lanes.



JUSTIFICATION

Lathrop Street is currently designated as

- Major Collector (C-4-70)

Lathrop is approximately

- 1 mile long for the proposed amendment segment from Wallisville to IH-10
- 2 miles long

Lathrop extends from Wallisville Road to Clinton Drive. It is primarily a major collector that serves the Houston Harbor and Liberty Heights Neighborhood. It also provides connection to IH10. The current traffic volume is 7,806 ADT for 2011 and is projected to be 10,540 ADT in 2035.

Public Works & Engineering is requesting to reclassify Lathrop Street between Wallisville Road and IH10 from a Major Collector with four lanes (C-4-70) to a Major Collector with two lanes (C-2-70) with a continuous center turn lane. Basis for the recommendation is the outcome from Pre-Engineering under the ReBuild Houston program (www.rebuildhouston.org).
