- **AW2 Program participants in the process of medical retirement**
- **Veterans/AW2 Program participants medically retired with an Army disability rating of 30% or greater**

Those who have served and fully qualify for announced and/or posted positions may seek career opportunities, both classified and civilian, providing they meet ALL requirements (including passing physical and psychological evaluations for those seeking positions as peace officers) as they are publicly announced. In addition, HPD and the City of Houston, one of the largest employers in the Houston area, may receive applications/inquiries from a vast pool of well-trained candidates with military backgrounds.

POLICE OFFICER TRAINEES CLASS B IDENTIFICATION OFFICERS MODIFIED ENTRY OFFICERS

Service men or women interested in pursuing opportunities at the Houston Police Department as **POLICE OFFICER TRAINEES***, **CLASS B IDENTIFICATION OFFICERS***, **MODIFIED ENTRY OFFICERS**** must meet ALL requirements, including passing physical and psychological evaluations, in addition to passing all phases of the screening process. *Police Officer Trainee and Class B Identification Officer Trainee positions require that applicants register for and pass publicly announced Civil Service Examinations designated specifically for these positions. Requirements are sixty (60) semester hours with a 2.0 GPA from an accredited college/university OR military service with an honorable discharge (additional requirements are applicable). PAT (Physical Agility Test) information applicable to these classified positions is available on the HPD web page at <http://www.houstonpolice.org> (Careers).

**Modified Entry Officer positions require experience as follows: Must be currently employed as a municipal, county or state law enforcement officer OR have been so employed within one year of making application and in addition, meet all other requirements for a Police Officer Trainee.
