Those who have served and fully qualify for *available* and/or *posted positions* may seek career opportunities, both classified and civilian, providing they meet ALL requirements. Those applicants seeking positions as a **POLICE OFFICER** must complete all phases of the extensive screening process including passing physical and psychological evaluations.
