**Houston Municipal Courts Department Hosts Court Clinics Before 2015 Great Texas  
Warrant Round Up Begins**

HOUSTON, Texas – In a continuing effort to provide court information to Houston's diverse population, the City of Houston's Municipal Courts Department is hosting Municipal Court Clinics on February, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015. The court clinics are designed to help citizens understand how to resolve their court cases before the 2015 Great Texas Warrant Round Up begins on March 7, 2015.

*"Municipal Courts Clinic activities enable those we serve to become better acquainted with the various services available to them to help them take care of their court matters,"* said Director and Presiding Judge, Barbara E. Hartle. *"It will also complement our efforts to inform citizens that if they or their loved ones have outstanding traffic tickets, to get them resolved before The Great Texas Warrant Round Up begins March 7<sup>th</sup>, when area law enforcement officers will begin arresting those that have outstanding warrants in earnest,"* Judge Hartle stated.

The Clinics are being held at the following Houston Parks and Health & Human Services Departments community multi-service centers without the presence of law enforcement officers or judges:

- Sharpstown Multi-Service Center – 6600 Harbor Town, 77051; 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

English and Spanish-speaking Municipal Courts staff will be on hand at each clinic to answer questions and help people obtain information about their court case(s), warrants, and other helpful court and public safety information, including distracted driving prevention.
