Dear Resident:

We are developing a new Tree Waste Recycling Pilot Program and we need your help. This program will help us save significant tax dollars and develop a successful green waste recycling system that can be expanded to all of Houston.

Tree waste makes up 30 to 40 percent of heavy trash volume we collect and send to landfills. Recycling this material is cheaper than landfilling it, plus it creates enormous savings for Houston taxpayers. Virtually all tree waste that is properly separated and bundled can be diverted from landfills and re-used.

**Here's where your cooperation is critical:** In January, May and September 2008, place your "Junk Waste" only (heavy trash) out on your scheduled heavy trash day. All other months between October 2007 and August 2008, place Tree Waste only at the curb on your scheduled heavy trash day. (See schedule on reverse side)

**"Tree Waste"** is considered tree limbs, branches, stumps, and bushes.

We are excited about the many benefits! **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING  
THE "TREE WASTE RECYCLING PILOT PROGRAM"**

- Place **only** your "Tree Waste" items at the curb on designated months. (Refer to your enclosed schedule and chart below.)
- "Tree Waste" is "clean wood waste" which consists of tree limbs, branches, stumps, and bushes. NO FURNITURE-TYPE WOOD.
- Place your "Junk Waste" items, which were previously referred to as "heavy trash" items, at the curb in January 2008, May 2008, and September 2008. The other months are **"Tree Waste"** only months.
