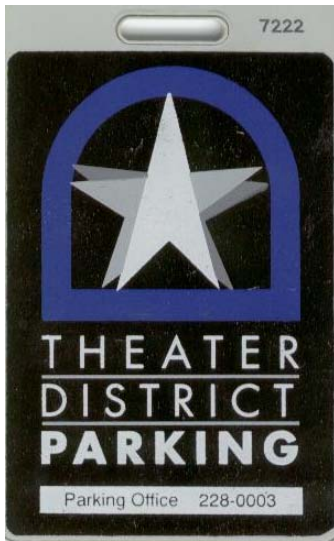

The **Theater District Parking Garage** in conjunction with Convention & Entertainment Facilities Department of the City of Houston have set up a collection box for gifts that will be donated to the Star of Hope and be given to the almost 300 homeless children and the nearly 500 adults that will be spending their Christmas at the Star of Hope.

Access Card holders can donate gifts such as diapers, all types and sizes of clothes, and school supplies at our temporary drop-off site in the parking office, which is located on the Green Level near Entrance #1 off of Rusk Street. All donations are needed by December 10, 2002 to allow time for wrapping. The Star of Hope has the following gift-giving guidelines: a) *gifts must*

be donated unwrapped; b) Only new items will be accepted please; and c) the following items cannot be accepted: bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates, crayons, Pokeman, any toy with a frightening appearance, large toys, play dough, toy guns, perishable goods, and Harry Potter items.
