Each individual shall consent to and complete state or federal forms that are required to obtain a **criminal history report for a Sexually Oriented Business Enterprise entertainer / manager permit**. Permits for sexually oriented business enterprise entertainers and managers may be denied, revoked, suspended or denied for renewal if the applicant or permittee has been convicted of any of the designated offense(s) within the five-year period immediately preceding the date of the filing of the application; has spent time in jail or prison during the five-year period immediately preceding the date of the filing of the application for such a conviction; or if the holder has been convicted of any of the designated offenses since the application was filed. Such offense(s) described in chapters 43, 21, 22 or 25 of the Texas Penal Code include: prostitution, promotion of prostitution, aggravated promotion of prostitution, and compelling prostitution; obscenity; sale, distribution or display of harmful material to a minor; sexual performance by a child, employment harmful to children, or possession or promotion of child pornography; public lewdness, indecent exposure or indecency with a child; sexual assault or aggravated sexual assault; harboring a runaway child; criminal attempt, conspiracy or solicitation to commit any of the above offenses; or any violation of article VIII of chapter 28 of this code.

Due to the requirement of the criminal history report, applicants for a Sexual Oriented Business Enterprise Entertainer/Manager permit must apply in person.
