0 BARC partners with over 150 nonprofit rescue groups. RPM is by far BARC's largest and mos 9 rescue partner. % Transferred to RPM = # transferred to RPM/total transfers.

98.77% BARC pays RPM \$75 for every animal they rescue. As BARC's first and only high volume rescu RPM is an integral part of BARC's live release success.
