The above summarizes the FY2009 Budget, and the FY2009 Estimate for the Sign Administration Fund. Also included are the beginning and ending fund balances, total available resources and total expenditures. In FY2010, the Sign and Administration Fund will be merged with the Building Inspection Fund.

The mission of the Sign Administration Division of the Public Works & Engineering Department is to administer the sign code within both the Houston city limits and the City's extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ). Outdoor sign permit and license fees are budgeted in the Sign Administration Fund to support enforcement of the City's sign ordinances. The code requires the licensing of sign contractors, construction permits for new signs including examination and plan approval, and operating permits for new and existing signs.

**Note:**

The Sign Administration Fund was combined with the Building Inspection Fund. The Sign Administration Ending Fund Balance of \$2,280,566 will be combined into the FY2010 Building Inspection Beginning Fund Balance for a total of \$17,309,208. Please see page X - 130.

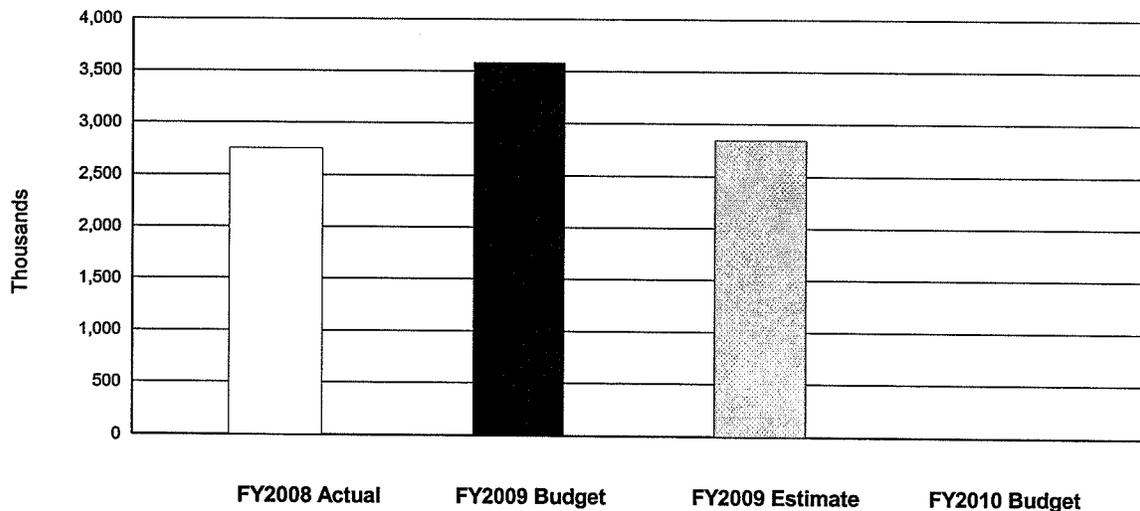
