### Department Organization

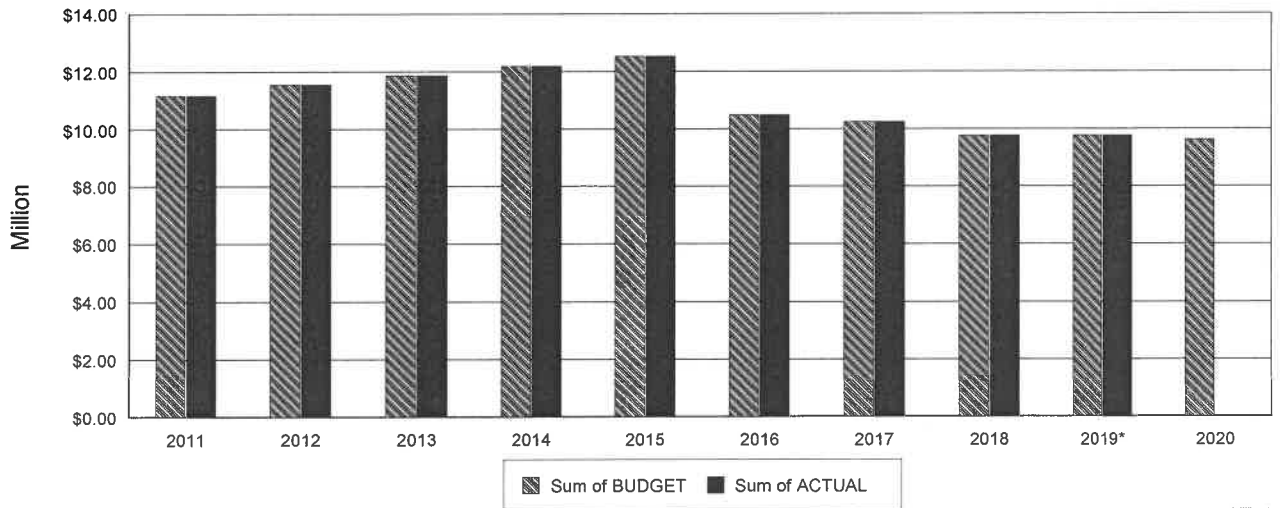
